The Brothers of the Omicron Phi Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. are pleased to make available two scholarship opportunities targeting African-American Males. The *Ronald W. Sims Memorial Scholarship* is designed for academically talented, graduating, African-American males who are applying to a 4-Year, degree granting, college or university as a full time student. The Major (Ret.) *Henry Montgomery Leadership Scholarship* is presented to a deserving African-American, male student that participated in JROTC throughout his high school career and wishes to pursue a 4-Year college education. Both scholarships offer a one-time award of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) each, given in honor of the late Ronald W. Sims and Henry Montgomery, noted and devoted Members of the Omicron Phi Lambda Chapter and loyal servants to the communities of South Metropolitan Atlanta.

The recipient of each award will be an African-American male, high school senior who has at least a 2.8 GPA and meets the following minimum requirements: 400 Math and 430 Verbal on the SAT or an 18 English and 16 Math score on the ACT. The individuals selected will be interviewed and must demonstrate a strong desire to succeed and become positive contributors to his respective community. Each award is given with no stipulations for its use except that it must be used to further the recipient's college education. As a result, each recipient must show proof of admission and enrollment at a 4-Year, degree granting college or university.

Please advise any deserving seniors of this scholarship opportunity and have them complete the application form with appropriate attachments and return them prior to March 20th, 2009. You may make as many copies as necessary to provide to your students or simply have them request an application packet via e-mail at the address below.
